IF YOU ALREADY HAVE A PHOTO ID, YOU ARE READY TO VOTE. BE SURE TO BRING YOUR ID WITH YOU TO THE POLLING PLACE.

IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A PHOTO ID CARD, YOU NEED TO GET ONE BEFORE GOING TO VOTE. FREE IDENTIFICATION CARDS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND YOUR COUNTY VOTER REGISTRATION AND ELECTIONS OFFICE.

IF YOU HAVE A REASONABLE IMPEDIMENT TO OBTAINING PHOTO ID, YOU MAY VOTE WITH YOUR NON-PHOTO VOTER REGISTRATION CARD AFTER COMPLETING AN AFFIDAVIT AT THE POLLS.

IF YOU DO NOT HAVE PHOTO ID AND DO NOT HAVE A REASONABLE IMPEDIMENT TO OBTAINING ONE, OR SIMPLY FORGOT TO BRING YOUR PHOTO ID WITH YOU TO THE POLLING PLACE, YOU MAY STILL VOTE A PROVISIONAL BALLOT. HOWEVER, FOR YOUR VOTE TO COUNT YOU MUST PROVIDE PHOTO ID TO THE COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION PRIOR TO CERTIFICATION OF THE ELECTION.

IF YOUR REGISTRATION CARD IS LOST OR MISPLACED, A DUPLICATE CARD MAY BE OBTAINED, EVEN ON ELECTION DAY, BY CONTACTING YOUR COUNTY VOTER REGISTRATION AND ELECTIONS OFFICE.
